- Who does what ?
- CEC Commission on Education and Communication drives change for the co-creation of sustainable solutions through leading communication, learning and knowledge management in IUCN and the wider conservation community.
- CEESP Commission on Environmental, Economic and Social Policy provides expertise and policy advice on economic and social factors for the conservation and sustainable use of biological diversity.
- WCEL World Commission on Environmental Law advances environmental law by developing new legal concepts and instruments, and by building the capacity of societies to employ environmental law for conservation and sustainable development.
- CEM Commission on Ecosystem Management provides expert guidance on integrated ecosystem approaches to the management of natural and modified ecosystems.
- SSC Species Survival Commission advises the Union on the technical aspects of species conservation and mobilizes action for those species that are threatened with extinction.
- WCPA World Commission on Protected Areas promotes the establishment and effective management of a worldwide representative network of terrestrial and marine protected areas.
